## **GUIDELINE FOR AUTHORS:**

Manuscripts in French or English will be considered. Manuscript submissions should follow *Chicago Manual of Style* guidelines. Authors are asked to submit a copy of the essay via the journal website ([jffp.org](http://jffp.org)) and include a 200 word abstract.

## **STATEMENT ON OPEN ACCESS:**

In addition to print subscriptions, the *Journal of French and Francophone Philosophy* is published electronically. The *Journal of French and Francophone Philosophy* is an open source and open access journal ([jffp.org](http://jffp.org)) and operates under the [Creative Commons license 3.0](https://creativecommons.org/licenses/by-nc-nd/3.0/) (Attribution/Non-Commercial/No Derivative Works). Under this license and agreement, authors retain copyright and grant the journal the right of first publication. The copyright terms of the Creative Commons license 3.0 apply to both the electronic and the print versions of the journal.

Our rationale for operating as an open access journal is simple: we want the widest distribution possible for the ideas expressed in the journal. With open access, the articles published in the *Journal of French and Francophone Philosophy* are available to scholars and students without library subscription. Given the international scope of the journal - addressing ideas in and from the francophone world - maximizing access to scholarship is paramount.

Only published articles are given as open access. The names and email addresses entered in this journal site will be used exclusively for the stated purposes of the journal and will not be made available for any other purpose or to any other party.
